

And working daily to help the most disadvantaged part of the local community by giving, for example, economical support to elderly people, widows and needy families, medical assistance to sick people, building water wells and, in general, doing our best holding out a helping hand to those who need it.

Fior di Loto is a project that was born in Pushkar in 2003. We realized that help was needed in this community and we decided to give our best with passion and enthusiasm. From that day we became a strong family and nothing will stop us from keeping on with it!



### 3000 Covid Relief Family Food Packs

As you all know, Luli was in charge of the school renovation project when the lockdown caught her in Pushkar and she decided to stay and not return to her country; aware that most of the population in India lives on daily income, Luli decided to donate the remaining money from the renovation of the school to provide food packages to 40 families during the hard times of the lockdown.

When she told Dalia Salem, a friend and confinement partner at the hotel, she was motivated to help and try to raise money.

Both inadvertently became involved in the so needed project of providing food aid to those suffering the consequences of the Lockdown. For more than two months it was possible to raise funds and help with 3,000 food packages to the population of Pushkar and surrounding municipalities.

While Luli and Dalia had to be locked up in the hotel, Deepu Maharshi, our brother and founder of the school right with his wife, Laxmi Maharshi, and children were working extremely hard every day to be able to manage these packages. The calls Deepuji received were daily and too numerous. Deepuji once again has shown us how his dedication is of pure love and heart and how even in times when many feared for their own health, both Deepuji, his family and his people put the needs of others before their own.

Proud and grateful for the teamwork that we were able to make, thanks to all the donations we received, thanks to the heart and solidarity of the donors and of course thanks to the dedication of our wonderful Covid Team.

## Supply of monthly food packages

After delivering these 3000 packages during the first two months of confinement, the foundation has managed to supply packages with food to 125 families monthly, plus some extras that we have been able to deliver depending on the donations that we have been receiving throughout this time.

This past year we also had the enormous help of one of our sponsors who managed to raise money to help 31 widows throughout 2020. It was such a huge blessing to our widows since the project had no funds and we doubted if we could continue helping them during 2020.

# Reiki babies

The Reiki Babies project is a health programme started by the Fior di Loto Foundation with the aim to help young girls and women without resources to give birth in a suitable and safe environment: the Shyama Bagh Momorial Hospital in Pushkar. The cost of each birth and mother's care is  $\pounds$  (60 $\pounds$ ). This year, despite Covid-19, we managed to provide care for 64 mothers and their babies. Such a huge achievement!

### A letter from Carole

#### 1/2/2019

Today is a very special day for me as founder of the Knottingley Reiki Group UK.

My friend of almost 17 years Deepu Maharshi introduced me to a lady named Reena Modi Bagh. We spoke of the plight of woman/ girls from some of the poorest areas and the difficulties they encountered during pregnancy and childbirth.

We decided we all wanted a safe and secure environment for these ladies to receive medical help and the best experience possible when bringing their children into the world. Reiki Babies came from this conversation

The babies would be born in Shyama Bagh Memorial Hospital in Pushkar.

The cost of delivering a baby and any medical treatment the mother may need would be €60. The mother will be given advice and support throughout as will the baby, who will also receive a certificate of birth.

We all wanted a safe and secure environment for these ladies to receive medical help and the best experience possible when bringing their children into the world.

On 3/2/2019 our first Reiki baby was delivered safely, since that time 64 babies have been born and 64 mothers have had the support and care they deserve.

I would like to give a massive thank you to Deepu Maharshi to Reena ModiBag, to every person that has sponsored this wonderful program and to the amazing lady that is Mara Sandri, the founder of Fior Di Loto.

I received this message from the wonderful lady that delivers all our Reiki babies Reena Modi Bagh. I spent a day with Reena teaching her energy healing on our visit to Pushkar.

#### Message:

"Hello everyone! I can't stop writing because this baby is really a miracle!

As you know it is time of lockdown! Membrane rupture 3 days before ! mother of baby waited long to deliver at home because it is difficult to come to hospital ! When she came condition not good ! Internal OS is not dialeted ! keep her waiting with drugs but nothing worked! I was really worried !! then I remember Carole and start doing Quantum!! in 15 min when I check it is already 3 fingers dialeted and at 5 pm the mother had this beautiful baby!

Dear Carole life is full of miracles only we have to believe in it !!thanks!! thanks to all sponsors to all dear friends dear mara ji dear Godalupeji and last but not least Deepuji who constantly encourages me!! Today is big day! Another day of success, a reason to smile."

After the two months of confinement in the hotel, Luli decided to go back to school and finish it as she envisioned it when the renovation began, full of love and decoration details that made each class a little different.

The confinement paralyzed the world and in turn gave Luli time to finish her project with all the details and the love that she wanted for the girls. The renovation of our school was completed after 6 months of constant work and dedication to our girls.

Nor could they dance Bollywood songs, which is already common every year on this day. But they were able to keep the Christmas Basket Giveaway. As every year, they prepared baskets with typical Christmas food and products that the families had previously brought to the center. So, in advance, the teachers sold the ballots at the doors during the times of entering and leaving the center. And on the selected day, a raffle was made with representation of the families and the school. The winning ballots were posted on the web. And one more year they were able to collaborate in the improvement of the education for the girls of Fior di Loto.
